
## Canada Bishop Now Venerable

Paris — (NC) — This city will mark the 300th anniversary of the death of St. Vincent de Paul in a solemn public ceremony on the week of March 13.

The Superior General of the Vincentian Fathers, Father William M. Slatery, G.M., a native of Baltimore, will celebrate Mass at the principal public ceremony on March 16. It will take place at the church of the Claretians, the general of Paris where St. Vincent was a parish priest in 1612.

CARDINAL FELTEN of Paris and papal legats to the tricentennial celebrations in France will be solemnly received at Notre Dame Cathedral here March 14. That same evening Minister of Justice Edmond Michelet will preside at a meeting in honor of St. Vincent.

There will be a special ceremony in Notre Dame cathedral for the elderly and the poor, the special objects of St. Vincent's zeal.

Worldwide celebrations in honor of the two saints will reach a peak around September 27, date of St. Vincent's death. He is regarded as a national hero in France because of his reforms in such charitable works as the care of orphans and foundlings. Foundlings of his day were frequently sold to beggars, who mutilated them to make them more visible and then led them around as a means of obtaining more alms.

The community of priests founded by St. Vincent de Paul, is formally known as the Congregation of the Mission. It has about 8,000 members. There are about 45,000 Despatches of Charity throughout the world.
