### Legion Praizes Movie About Nuns

New York—(N.Y.)—The National Legion of Decency has recommended the movie "Conspiracy of Hearts" dealing with nuns who rescued Jewish orphans from Nazis.

Legion officials said the film in the sixth to be specifically recommended by the organization in a drive to promote good movies.

Classifying the film as A1, morally unacceptable for general patronage, the Legion said:

"Men are nagger too," says Dr. Winfred Overholser, superintendent of St. Elizabeth's Hospital in Washington. "And why women put up with them, I'll never know."
