Vocational Series Set At Nazareth College

Charles Gaylord of the Federal Internal Revenue office in Buffalo, spoke Wednesday to freshmen and sophomores at Nazareth College about opportunities in the Government service for college women.

The following day, William Cox Jr., personnel officer of the Rochester Public Library, outlined the work of the library for a group of interested freshmen. Today at the Sophomore Dean's Hour, three successful business women will present a program on other opportunities for college women.

MISS MILDRED CRAMER, George, system service representative of Security Trust Company, will speak on Nazareth College; a group of banking opportunities; Miss Paulette Flanagan, claims agent at our communications media — Travelers Insurance Company; Miss Dorothy Cotton, WHEC, will talk about Insurance; Mrs. McLaughlin, Runcill Ad. Mrs. Marianne Tuck, personnel advertising Agency and Robert director at Photostat Corp.; Smett, Catholic Courier Journal, will present various types and a film on Social work of positions open to college women shown to the Freshmen class.

Later in the month, Mrs. Bittner, supervisor of the trained program at Sibley, will speak from the New York State Department of Health and Dr. Charles Shellabarger, a lecturer on Radiation Biology.







Modern Language Lab Set Up At Mercy

A modern language laboratory at Our Lady of Mercy High School opened its doors for the first time last week to the school's foreign language students.

Located on the school's second floor, the room is equipped with 24 individual desk-size compartments, each complete with pegboard partition upon which hangs a pair of earphones. In addition to the tape recorder, a film projector, screen, and opaque shades are also part of the room's facilities.
