Lamoureux Orchestra Set For Concert

The Schuman Memorial Foundation will sponsor the final concert of the season on Sunday, April 3 at 8:30 p.m. at the Auditorium Theatre with the Lamoureux Orchestra of Paris, directed by Igor Markevitch.

Scheduled on the program are Schubert's Symphony No. 3, the Beethoven Fifth, Debussy's "La Mer" and an orchestral suite from Manuel de Falla's "Three-Cornered Hat". Tickets will be available at the Auditorium box office.

THE FOUNDATION WAS CREATED in memory of the composer Robert Schumann and his wife, Clara, to provide study and other educational opportunities for musicologists and students, and to foster the idea of world peace through music education.

Markevitch made his American debut with the Boston Symphony in 1955 after 30 years musical experience in Europe as pianist, composer and conductor. The Lamoureux Orchestra was founded in 1938 by Charles Lamoureux and has served to premiere musical masterworks of Ravel, Dukas, Debussy, Saint-Saens, D'Indy, and Rousset. Such artists as Pablo Casals and Yehudi Menuhin made their Paris debuts with the group.
