Such, at least, is what Jesuit Father William M. Abbott did this past weekend. He was in Rochester to give a retreat at the Canisius Retreat House.

FATHER ABBOTT is on the staff of America, weekly magazine published by U.S. Jesuits. His tape recorded broadcast was aired over the ABC radio network program "Christian in Action" sponsored by the National Council of Catholic Men.

Archbishop Hurley, first Archbishop of the city of Durban—where violence flared in clashes between whites and blacks this week, has headed the turbulent diocese for nine years. He is 48, one of the world's youngest prelates.

And they stripped Him and put on Him a scarlet cloak; and plaiting a crown of thorns, they put it upon His head, and a reed into His right hand; and bending the knee before Him they mocked Him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews! Now as they went they met a man of Cyrene named Simon, and they compelled him to take up His cross. And they called Golgotha, that is, the Place of the Skull. And there they crucified Him, and two robbers with Him, one on His right hand and one on His left. Now there were three hours past, and they cried out, saying, Thou God of David, deliver Him. And at the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani, that is, My God, My God, hast Thou forsaken me? And when some of the bystanders hearing that, said, This man is calling Elias, and immediately one of them ran, and took a sponge, and offered it to Him to drink. But the rest said, Wait, let us see whether Elias is coming to save Him. But Jesus again cried out with a loud voice, and gave up His spirit.
