### Monks Aid Polio Fight

Cambridge (RNS)—Some 1,300 volunteers in a research project for a new type of oral polio vaccine included 123 Trappist monks of St. Joseph's Abbey at Spencer, Mass.; it was made known here.

Dr. Victor J. Cabbaso reported on the experiment at a meeting of the Massachusetts Public Health Association at the Harvard Medical School. He is associated with Dr. Herald R. Cox under whose leadership the oral vaccine was developed by the Lederle Laboratories.

The report indicated that reaction to a single dose of the "live" oral vaccine is comparable to or slightly better than results from the triple-shot in-oculation method. Population sampling of the vaccine continues in many parts of the country.

The newspaper, Haaretz, said Mr. Ben-Gurion's action may damage Israel's international standing.
