"Ben-Hur," winner of 11 Academy Awards including Best Picture, will start its reserved seat engagement at Schine's New Riviera Theatre on Friday, May 13. Indian Stew

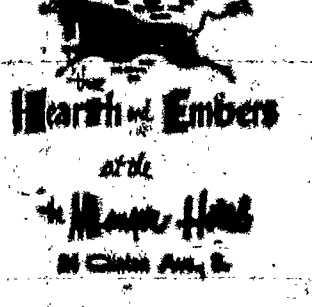

Another adult western hits the Law's Theatre screen in new ways. For ADULTS AND ADOLESCENTS as Director John Huston, with his customary skill and artistry, gives us "THE UNFORGIVEN."
There is a real "stew" of acting talent in this 125 minute movie. Burt Lancaster and Audrey Hepburn share the starring roles but there are favorites for all age groups. For example, there's John Saxon and John Huston, the younger group and artist, gives us "THE UNFORGIVEN."
THE SCENE is the Texas Panhandle immediately after the Civil War at a time of hatred between the white settlers and the local Kiowa Indians. This situation explodes in senseless massacres and excesses on the part of both Indians and whites. In the midst of all this tension, it's discovered that Miss Hepburn (the hisher Indian name?) is actually a full-blooded (Red Cross please note) Indian. The desire of the Indians to recover their own, the resentment of the white settlers to have an "enemy" in their midst, and the determination to hold on to the land who has been a member of the family since birth provides the crux of the conflict.
