### Watching The Screen

## Indian Stew

Another adult western hits the Loew's Theatre screen next week for ADULTS AND ADOLESCENTS as Director John Huston, with his customary skill and wit, gives us "THE UNFORGIVEN."

There is a real "stew" of acting talent in this 125 minute movie. Burt Lancaster and Audrey Hepburn share the starring roles but there are favorites for all age groups. For example, there's John Saxon and Audie Murphy for the younger group and two great artists of the screen, Lillian Gish and Charles Bickford, for the senior citizens.

THE SCENE is the Texas Panhandle immediately after the Civil War at a time of hatred between the white settlers and the local Kiowa Indians. This situation is set in a series of scenes that take place on the part of both Indians and whiter. In the midst of all this tension, a discovery that Miss Hepburn (is this her Indian name?) is actually a full-blooded (Red Cross) Indian. The daughter of the Indians' warrior chief, the resentment of the settlers in having a "enemy" in their midst and the determination to hold on to the girl who has been a member of the family since birth provides the crux of the conflict.

Until Miss Hepburn's origin is brought out into the open, mystery and suspense hold the audience. Naturally, with Burt Lancaster we expect to see a good old-fashioned partner battle. And sure enough we have one. The Lancaster household and the Indian tribe don't exactly sit down to tea. Between the Indian fights and the verbal battles among the settlers, there's ample opportunity to show cattle roundups and a horse taming session.

Our most decorated hero of World War II, Audie Murphy, is surprisingly good as Lancaster's hot-headed brother whose hatred of Indians causes him to abandon his family. Good acting from a fine cast makes this western filmed in Mexico in Panavision and Technicolor well worth viewing. For the music lovers Dimitri Tiomkin's score.
