London — (NC) — "Keep religion out of it" has become a modern heresy, a Catholic prelate has charged here.

Bishop John A. Murphy of Shrewsbury, writing in the Christian Democrat, decried the viewpoint that permits the supernatural to be regarded as effective only after death.

Bishop Murphy asserted: "Against a little bit of the supernatural, the natural, alibi, the unnatural. Not without reason are we fighting in our day such unnatural trends as euthanasia, contraceptives, sterilization and therapeutic abortion. The absence of a supernatural viewpoint explains them all."

Methodist Group Visits Catholic Seminary

Bloomington — (NC) — A Methodist minister and 28 of his parishioners took a first hand look at a Catholic seminary here and apparently liked what they saw.

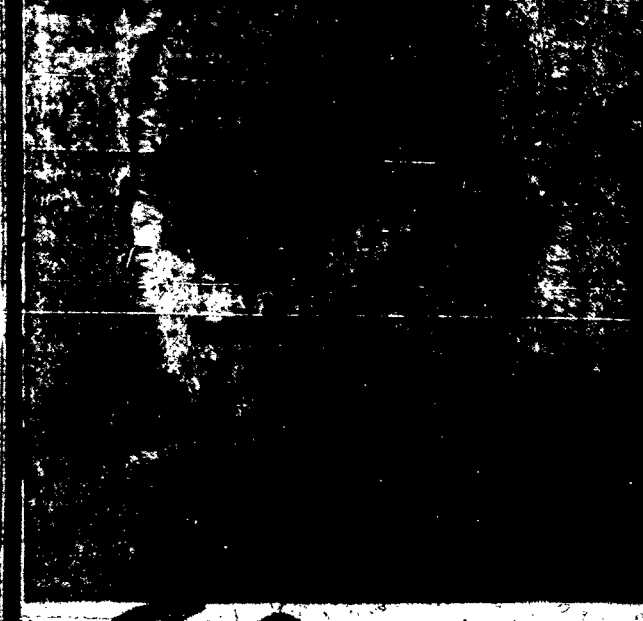
