St. Jerome's Graduates First Class

St. Jerome's School, East Aurora, N.Y., held its first graduation ceremony in the church on Thursday evening, June 23.

Under the guidance of the pastor, Rev. Ray B. Murphy, the school was opened with a total enrollment of 50 children in kindergarten and first grade in Sept. 1952. Each year since that time a new grade has been added until now the school has 8 grades and enrollment of over 500 pupils.

Forty-one boys and girls listened as the Very Rev. Charles J. Lavery, C.S.B., president of St. John Fisher College, congratulated them on being a part of this development and reminded them of the honor that was theirs in being members of this first graduating class.

PRESENTATION OF a partial scholarship was made at the graduation exercises. It is a scholarship, sponsored by the Home-School Association, is awarded on the basis of scholastic achievement.

The ceremony was concluded with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.
