**German Aid Red Refugees**

Kew-Forest (RNS) — More than 100,000 home units for refugees have been completed by Catholic building associations in West Germany since the end of World War II. It was disclosed at the group's annual conference here.  
Migr. Franz Wenzlmaier, director of the Catholic Settlement Service, top authority for the associations, said 75 per cent of the units accommodate one or two families. He said the Church feels such units are more desirable for sociological, moral and health reasons than apartment buildings which are the predominant type of accommodation in Germany, especially in cities and industrial areas.

**\$7 Million New Hospital**

Philadelphia (RNS) — Nazareth Hospital, a 200-bed institution operated here by the Sisters of the Holy Family of Nazareth, is planning a \$7,500,000 three-wing addition to double its present facilities and capacity.  
The program calls for the largest investment in new facilities ever made by any non-profit medical school hospital in Philadelphia, about \$2,500,000 of the cost will be covered by a federal grant under the Hill-Burton Act.

**Nigerian Pilgrimage Marks Independence**

Lagos (RNS) — Marking Nigeria's independence from Britain, which officially takes place October 1, some 100 pilgrims left Lagos for Lisbon on the first leg of a trip that will take them to Fatima, Lourdes and Rome, dependence, he said there are many good and evil influences at work in Nigeria as is taken her place among the nations.
