Glad Game

The magic name of Walt Disney brings Eleanor Porter's old-fashioned novel to life again for a new generation of youngsters and for the nostalgic pleasure of many of their elders in the thoroughly delightful "POLLYANNA" at the Palace Theatre for the WHOLE FAMILY. If the family happens to be on vacation this week, don't worry. Such wonderful entertainment MUST be held over for at least a second week.

Reverend Ford, a fire-and-brimstone preacher, who turns to the "glad" passages of the Bible for his sermons, and eventually Aunt Polly herself.

THE LEISURELY story centers around the building of a new orphanage, to which Aunt Polly is opposed, and the rallying of the now rebellious community in a big fund-raising bazaar. This affair with its musical and theatrical attractions and its band of elder citizens blaring out rhythmic music of the day is one of the film's highlights.

Hayley Mills is the young star who makes Pollyanna credible and this is the successful "family picture" it is. She conveys a child's candor without resort to either old-fashioned sentimentality or modern brashness. With this performance, Hayley seems headed toward a great career. Rarely have the attitudes and mannerisms of a child been reflected so expertly on the screen, certainly to the credit of writer-director David Swift, cast consisting largely of veterans has been assembled for this 133 minute picture. Jane Bryan, who is excellent in her role, Kurt Mendon, the enjoyable Adolphe Menjou, and the young veteran Kevin Corcoran. Yet even these veterans are completely overshadowed by the excellence of Hayley Mills.

More than 2,000 pipes have been revoiced, a new console and electronic controls installed and the cabinet refinished. The 50-year-old organ was repaired by the Tullers Co. of Erie at a total cost of \$11,000. Organmaster at St. Michael's for nearly half a century was the late Frederick Pohl, widely known for his mastery of the great organ. Present organist, at console in photo, is Mrs. Lillian Karna.

Off The Record

Flamenco

Columbia records has an interesting series called "Advances In Sound." It is a series of records recorded in strange lands by people playing strange instruments. The newest one is "Flamenco Spectacular" and was recorded in Spain at an authentic "Juerga Flamenco."

The translation of "Juerga Flamenco" would be meaningless without description in detail of some of the physical aspects of it. The literal meaning can be said to be Flamenco. Among the gypsies it is actually a debut of new talents, a contest of interpretation and opportunity for expression, during which singing, chanting and dancing prevail. The origin of these flamencos is almost unknown but it dates back centuries.

At the Juerga, there is never a program, no one knows exactly what to expect. Each participant has trained and rehearsed special presentations during which the singers and dancers endeavor to surpass each other. This record is thoroughly authentic, nothing deleted. THE COMMENTS, heckling and encouragements can be heard in the background, which is filled with enthusiasm almost to the point of distraction. The repertoire of numbers contained on the album are gypsy to the core. Music and chants were handed down from father to son, and most of the time oral sounds of the wild and furious by, as very little of the gypsy Juerga Flamenco.

Swiss Catholics Pray For Protestant Groups

Lausanne — (RNS) — Swiss Roman Catholics, under the inspiration of Bishop Francois Charriere of Lausanne, Geneva and Fribourg, have taken a close spiritual and practical interest in a Protestant youth gathering here regarded as one of the most important of its kind ever held. It is the first Ecumenical Youth Assembly in Europe sponsored by the Youth Department of the World Council of Churches. Scheduled for July 13 to 24, it was expected to attract some 1,700 Protestant and Eastern Orthodox youth from around the world. The Catholic Action movement in French-speaking Switzerland has asked its members to pray for the success of the assembly. It also has announced that it will send a group of observers to the meeting, whose theme is "Jesus Christ: the Light of the World." Meanwhile, in a statement published in Catholic Week, official publication of the Lausanne diocese, Bishop Charriere declared that although "the Catholic Church does not belong to the World Council of Churches, it teaches that all humble and sincere efforts aiming to reconcile Christians are the work of the Holy Spirit."
