### Martyr Shrine Tour Arranged

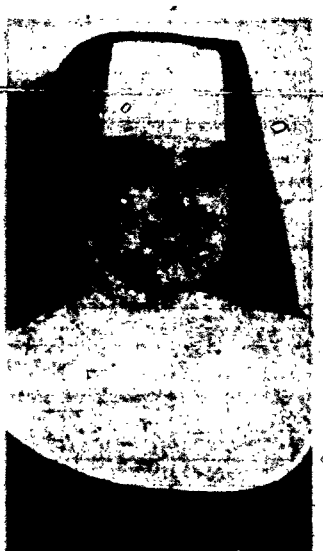
