At Home With Trudy McNell Melons - Melons Melons

It's wonderful to be home again after a memorable vacation in California. I've collected some excellent recipes and will be bringing them to you from time to time. One of the pleasures of today's eating is that there are always so many new and interesting foods to serve along with the familiar favorites. Markets are continually introducing you to new flavors, new textures and ideas for adding appeal to your daily menus.

While in San Francisco we were impressed with the wonderful fruits, strawberries, raspberries, prunes, dates and melons. Of course we grow perfectly wonderful melons right here in our own area and it's well to become familiar with them and to know different ways of using them. They are in abundant supply right now on your local market.

A GROUP OF THE newer items you will want to sample during the weeks to come also are the "specialty melons" arriving from the western area of the United States. These melons, all different in shape, color and texture are relatives of the well known cantaloupe, but each is inviting and tempting in its own right. There's the honeydew, casaba, cranshaw, Persian and even the less plentiful Christmas or Santa Claus melon, which will appear on the market later in the fall.

When selecting a honeydew for your family, look for one that has a nice creamy yellow rind with a sort of velvety feeling. The blossom end of the melon may yield slightly to pressure which indicates ripeness. You should find the flesh a pale green, very juicy, sweet and of fine-grained texture.

THE PERSIAN melon looks quite similar to the cantaloupe, though it is larger and the rind is a deep green under the even covering of fine netting. The flesh is a deep orange-pink, very thick and mildly sweet.

THE CASABA melon is large, almost globular in shape with very wrinkled, leathery furrows and a pointed stem. A butterscotch color to the rind indicates ripeness and the flesh is creamy white and meltingly juicy.

THE CRANSHAW melon, a favorite of many, is a cross between the Persian and Casaba.
