


3 Priest-Brothers Offer Masses At Forty Hours

Sodalists Set Workshop For Parish Heads

The program of the parish sodalists of the diocese of Rochester will be put into full swing for the 1960-61 year on Sunday, Sept. 23, with a workshop for all the moderators, officers, and leaders of these sodalists.

The purpose of the workshop, which is held annually, is to renew in the minds of the leaders the importance of the Sodality program.

THE WORKSHOP is to take place in St. Andrew's parish hall under the direction of the members of St. Andrew's adult Sodality and their moderator, the Rev. Michael Volpe. Father Volpe will open the workshop with a welcoming address at 2 p.m. Two conferences will follow the general assembly; the first is entitled "Officers—your job is important" and will be conducted by the Rev. Joseph P. Beattie, the director of the Diocesan Sodality Union.

The second is on the Sodality meeting and will be given by Father Volpe, the assistant director of the Sodality Union. A demonstration of the Sodality meeting utilizing the unit system will follow under the direction of the Sodalists.

This will be followed by a panel discussion on general questions asked about the Sodality. The panel will be composed of members of the Sodality deanery under the direction of Alan Grosser, deanery president, with the Rev. Michael Daly, assistant director of the Sodality Union as moderator.

THE PROGRAM will be completed with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, and a social hour in the school cafeteria. Several hundred Sodalists are expected.

Members voted to sell fruit cakes this year as a means of raising money to purchase kitchen utensils for the new school. Mrs. Alan Basque and Mrs. Francis Galis are co-chairmen.

Refreshments were served by Mrs. Edmund Gay and her committee.
