Tax War Planned To Battle Monks

Warsaw — (RNS) — The Executive Committee of the Polish Communist party has approved the draft of a new law that will place further restrictions on monastic orders in this country.

According to reports circulated here, the party has decided to liquidate the Catholic orders which, according to the Communists, prevent the spread of Marxist-Leninist ideas among the youth.

It was reported at the same time that new efforts also will be made to secularize the Catholic University of Lublin, the only institution of its kind permitted to function behind the Iron Curtain.

The proposed restrictions on Catholic Orders closely several others made recently by the government in its continuing fight against the monks.

Among these were tax measures that forced the Orders to sell buildings and land to meet the assessments. In some cases, Orders were forced to abandon their entire holdings. The same measures were responsible for the closing of Catholic seminaries in Gorow and in Slupsk, Western Poland.

Observers here have noted an ominous change in the government's attitude towards teachers of religion, many of whom have had their applications for license renewal turned down. Without a license, teachers are unable to continue instruction in the schools.

Springfield — (RNS) — The General Presbytery, largest and most representative policy board of the 1,000,000-member Assembly of God, adopted a resolution here opposing the election of a Roman Catholic as President of the U.S.

Disclaiming "religious bias," the resolution charged the Catholic Church with bigotry "as reflected in its position of infallibility of its leadership."
