Rev. Albert H. Schnacky, Diocesan Director of the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine, and Sister Maureen, M.H.S.P., of the Assumption School of Religion, Elmira, will address members of the eleventh regional congress of the C.C.D. in Syracuse the week-end of Oct. 7-9.

Father Schnacky will speak to a session concerned with the religious education of students in high school. His talk will be given on Saturday, Oct. 8 at 2:30 p.m. in the East Room of the Hotel Syracuse. Topic is: "Basic Content of High School Religion Course for Public School Boys and Girls."

SISTER MAUREEN will speak to a special session for catechistic Sisters on Friday, Oct. 7, at 2:30 p.m. in Parlor D of the hotel. Her topic will be "Effective Use of Liturgy in the Parish Religious Instruction Program."

Thirty-three other speakers from every diocese of New York State and from Illinois, Massachusetts, New Jersey, Connecticut, and Rhode Island will address the three-day congress in Syracuse.

A special training course for lay catechists will be conducted on Oct. 8 and 9, by Sister March, S.A., of the Diocese of Ogdensburg.

CORNING — A talk on the merits of a Catholic education was presented by the Rev. William Roche, a former Corningite and now Superintendent of Diocesan Schools, before some 125 members attending the initial meeting of the Parent-Teachers Club of St. Patrick's parish in the school hall last week.

Mrs. Edward Fanning, program chairman, introduced Sister Mary Isidore, new school principal, who in turn introduced members of her teaching staff.

Introduced by Mrs. Fanning, Father Roche affirmed that parents are the prime educators of their children, with two objectives, namely, that of educating the children for eternity, and also to teach them to live a profitable life on earth.

He pointed out that the teachers take over some of the specialization in this area in matters of routine at school. The teachers are constantly trying to improve on their methods, he added.

FATHER ROCHE urged that parents cooperate fully with teachers in their efforts. He then explained the courses, books, and testing methods being used in the Catholic Schools. He further likened Catholic Education to a wheel.
