## Reds Double Tax Monks In Poland

Berlin — (RNS) — Poland's communist government is clamping ruinous taxes on religious communities, it is reported here.

The Polish revenue bureau now is taking the combined incomes of all the members of religious communities to segregate income. It comes to 15 per cent. Levied on them twice as much as the members were taxed as individuals.

In Poland, an annual income of about \$800 of the official rate of exchange is taxed 15 per cent.

**\$6 Million To Notre Dame**

**Notre Dame** — (NC) — Notre Dame University will get a \$6 million grant from the Ford Foundation, provided the Indiana institution raises \$12 million on its own during the next three years.

The Holy Cross Fathers' Institution is one of five privately supported American universities chosen by the foundation to get unrestricted grants in a \$46 million "special program in education."

The other schools and their grants are: Stanford (Calif.) University, \$25 million; the Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, \$6 million; University of Denver, \$3 million, and Vanderbilt University, Nashville, Tenn., \$4 million.



Carberra (RNS) — A "Freedom from Hunger" campaign was launched here by the Federal Council of Catholic Women of Australia to help needy refugees in Hong Kong. The campaign already is receiving strong support. Four branches of the Catholic Women's League of the Archdiocese of Canberra-Goulburn initially raised \$2,000 pounds (\$5,720) to provide food for refugees and build simple cottages for them.
