Memorials

For those who can afford it, or who, through sacrifice wish to honor a loved one, Memorials are still available. The subscription for a Memorial is \$500 and higher. With a down-payment this amounts to less than \$15.00 a month, and returns you an outstanding gift that will be remembered for many years.

Benefactors

For those who feel they cannot afford a Memorial, but by sacrifice can do a little extra, a BENEFACTOR'S GIFT has been established at \$240. This amounts to only \$10.00 a month for twenty-four months. Each Benefactor will receive recognition with a suitable Certificate of Gratitude.

Builders

A third gift has been established so that every wage-earning Catholic can participate in this campaign. This is the BUILDER'S GIFT of 17¢. Payable over two years, this amounts to only \$3.00 a month or 17 cents a day. Certainly, with sacrifice, every wage-earning adult in the County can afford 17 cents a day.

Why A Minimum Gift?

The idea of 17¢ is a MINIMUM GIFT from EVERY WAGE EARNER in the County is not a figure merely taken out of the air. It is a very REALISTIC ONE. In order that these high schools be built so that Catholic boys and girls will not be torn away from the opportunity for a Catholic education we must not only reach our goal, but surpass it if possible. Based on the number of WAGE-EARNING ADULTS in the County, it is an absolute necessity that we receive a minimum gift of 17 cents per day from each one for the next twenty-four months.
