Blessings Promised By Our Lord

To Those Who Honor His Sacred Heart Revealed to St. Margaret Mary

1. I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
2. I will establish peace in their homes.
3. I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
4. I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all in death.
5. I will bestow abundant blessings upon their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source and the infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
9. I will bless every place in which an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
10. I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced.
12. I promise thee in the exercise of my mercy that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who communicate on the First Friday in nine consecutive months the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their Sacraments. My Precious Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

League of the Sacred Heart

Requisites For Membership

1. Enrollment as member in the League Register of your local Center.

See your Pastor or Chaplain to enroll.

2. Promise to recite daily the Morning Offering of your prayers, works, joys, and sufferings to the Sacred Heart. The promise does not bind under sin. The following formula is recommended:

"O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer Thee my prayers, works, joys, and sufferings of this day for all the intentions of Thy Sacred Heart, in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world, in reparation for my sins, for the intentions of all our Associates, for the reunion of Christendom and in particular for the General Intention recommended this month."

In addition to the Morning Offering members are asked to:

1. Receive Holy Communion each week, or at least monthly, in reparation for the sins and sacrileges committed against Our Lord, especially in the Blessed Sacrament.
2. Recite daily the Rosary or at least one decade, preferably with the family.
