

## Better Than Sterilization

### Buy Plows For India

**SAN FRANCISCO** — "A lot hasn't proved the answer the scientific empiricists have found from India and the U.S. is that the answer will sterilization," concluded the old patriarchal society and left India shorn of its 400 million people.
