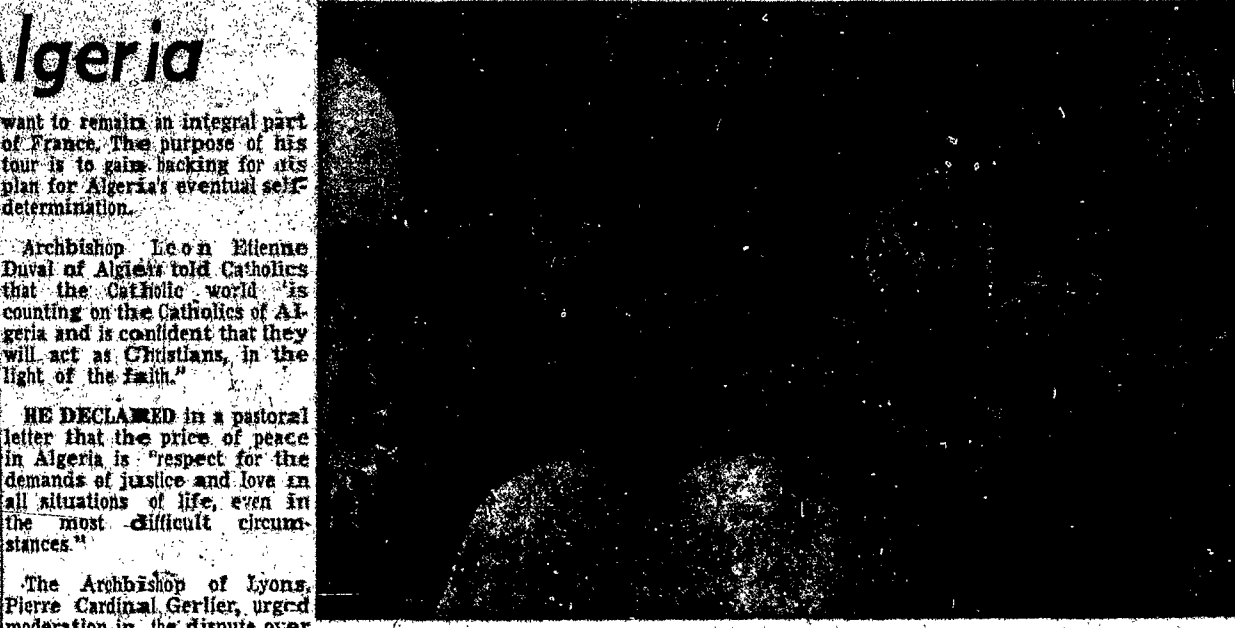

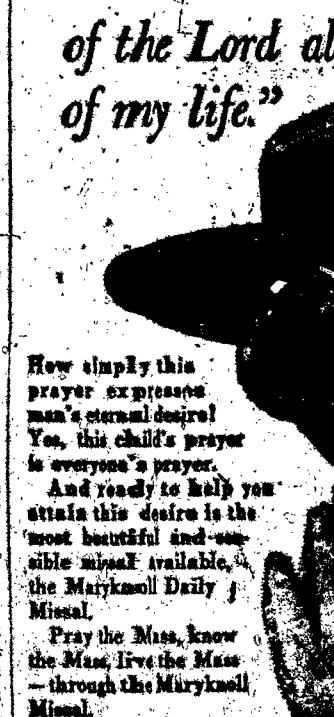

## Protestant Minister To Write On Council

New York — (RNS) — A special correspondent will go to Rome in the spring to prepare a series of articles for Religious News Service on the Second Vatican Council summoned by Pope John XXIII from the viewpoint particularly of Protestants interested in the problem of Christian unity.

He is the Rev. Claud D. Nelson, consultant on interreligious relations to the National Conference of Christians and Jews and former executive director of the Department of Religious Liberty of the National Council of Churches.

## Film Protest Endorsed

New York — (RNS) — Dr. Daniel A. Folling, editor of the Christian Herald, non-denominational Protestant monthly, endorsed a plea made by a Catholic bishop's committee for non-wide protest against moral objectionable films.

In an editorial prepared for the Herald's February issue, Dr. Folling declared: "We think it is high time that Protestants, Catholics and Jews, that indeed without regard to faith, get together in a positive program to support the every day decisions of the Council of American life and convenes and seeks to project to today's world a clearer picture of the Church's nature, pictures"

## Red Gains In Cuba Deplored

Havana — (RNS) — The Cuban hierarchy, in an open letter to Premier Fidel Castro, deplored the "Red" Communist "takeover" and staidous attacks on the Church by news agencies and radio stations which today are almost totally under the control of the government. DRAWN UP at a meeting of the bishops here, the letter also in it the hierarchy had been "painfully surprised" by a recent speech at the University of Havana in which Premier Castro accused the Catholic clergy of being counter-revolutionaries who were working against his regime in churches and educational centers.

## Church-State OK In Mexico

Chihuahua — A Mexican archbishop said Church-State relations in his country today are conducted in "a climate of mutual respect and comprehension which has made it possible to forget forever the frictions of the past." Archbishop Antonio Guizar y Valencia of Chihuahua made the comment in an interview in which he described the Mexican government as "zealously respectful of the liberty of worship" while fulfilling its role in the political and social spheres.
