Canandaigua Parish Drive Totals \$169,197

Canandaigua — Pledges totaling \$169,197 toward reduction of St. Mary's parish debt were reported this week by the Rev. Alphonsus P. Crimmens, pastor, at the close of a parishwide campaign.

Aim of the drive was a substantial reduction of the \$254,000 parish indebtedness, with a minimum goal of \$100,000 in two-year pledges.

FATHER CRIMMENS termed the pledge result "a tremendous tribute to the loyalty of our parishioners," and declared:

"The sacrifices of our people in pledging this amount are all the more significant because the parishioners have just completed paying more than \$220,000 during the last three years toward construction costs of our school and auditorium addition."

The pastor noted that of the \$169,197 drive total, \$132,623 represented new pledges and \$36,574 was in the form of re-pledges on balances from a 1957 fund campaign.

ST. MARY'S now has a complete parish facility — church school, convent, rectory and auditorium-gymnasium. Serving with Father Crimmens as assistant pastors are the Rev. William White and the Rev. Thomas Slatt.

Campaign chairman included advance gifts, Francis Finnick and Victor Falumbo, general secretary, Joseph Comella and Clifford Murphy Jr., and advisory, Robert Beck and Joseph McWilliams.
