

Pupils Boycott Ceylon Schools

Colombo — (NC) — The Catholics of Ceylon gave no quarter in their fight to keep their schools — even when the date set for the government takeover came. The children stayed away in droves. Most of the 220,000 pupils of the Catholic schools began to boycott them from November 28 on, even though the date for the government takeover was still three days off.

THE NATIONALIZATION bill passed in parliament in mid-November provided that all Catholic schools — those of grades I and II — should receive their former government subsidy and become tuition-charging institutions.

Forty-two of Ceylon's 48 Catholic schools in these categories decided to do so, as did 13 schools conducted by other religious bodies. Thus one-third of all Grade I and Grade II schools decided to stay out of the government plan.

But the great majority of Ceylon's 750 Catholic schools are Grade III, or vernacular schools, and the new law made their takeover by the government mandatory.

In close to 100 of these, Catholic parents erected barbed-wire barricades as much as 12 feet high and held themselves in to prevent government seizure.

The Catholic "occupation" took place all over the island and the men, women, and children who took up residence in the school buildings had the cooperation of other villagers who regularly brought them food and other necessities.

The schools in many cases became virtual little churches, with the continual chanting of prayer heard right into the night. The general practice was to hold a special holy hour every night from 11 o'clock until midnight.

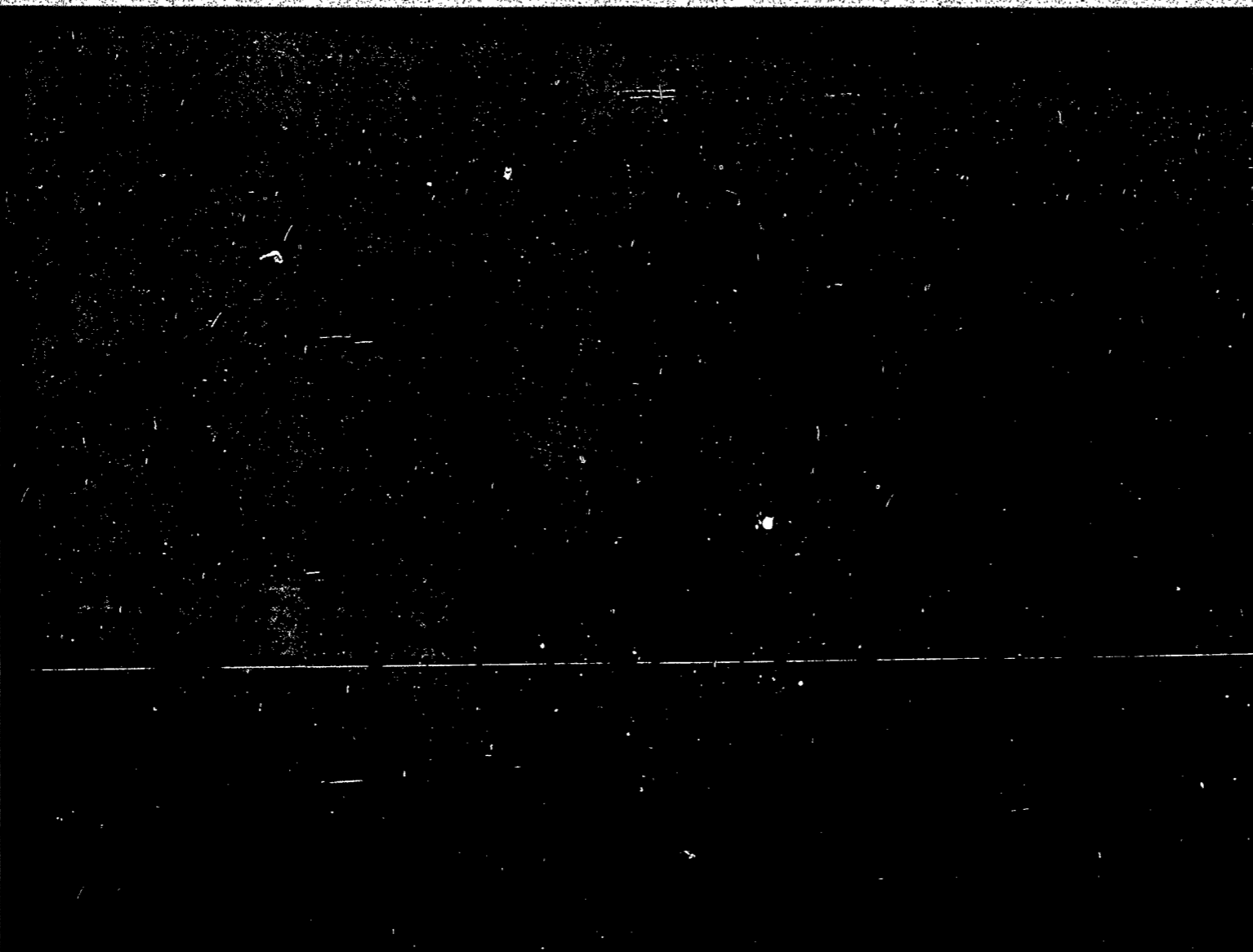

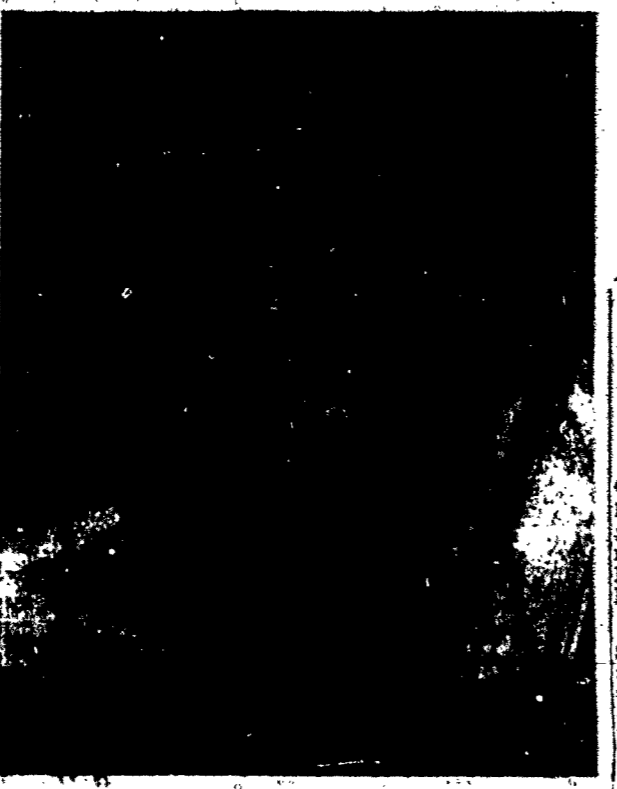

Family Bible For Inauguration

Boston — (RNS) — This old family bible, upon which President-elect John F. Kennedy will take his oath of office on January 20, contains a record of births, engagements, marriages, and deaths in the Fitzgerald and Kennedy families. Senator Kennedy's name (at arrow) appears with the birthdate May 24, 1917. The bible is the first Douay (Catholic) version ever used in a Presidential inauguration. It is presently owned by Thomas A. Fitzgerald of Dorchester, an uncle of the Senator.



Need For Spirituality Explained By Nun

Ithaca — Sister M. Cyrella of the Mission Helpers of the Sacred Heart was the speaker at the December meeting of the Parent-Educator and Child Study Club groups which was held in immaculate Conception Parish Hall. Her topic was "Spirituality in the Home."

Refugee Aid Program Plans Extension

Geneva — (RNS) — The Intergovernmental Committee for European Migration has been asked to consider extending its operations Made before an ICEM Council session here, the proposal was offered by Jean J. Chazard, who speaks on behalf of the Standing Conference of Voluntary Agencies Working for Refugees.

Chazard, deputy European director of Catholic Relief Services-National Catholic Welfare Conference (United States), said although the ICEM is not limited to categories of refugees it is, unfortunately, limited geographically.

"It seems to us (voluntary agencies) that the time may come when the field of action we as to include refugees from non-European areas where its assistance could provide services not at present given by any intergovernmental body," he said.

The 28-nation ICEM was established in 1951 to stimulate migration from Western Europe's 6 A areas and has since relocated over a half-million refugees.

Chazard told the delegates his request was in line with an earlier plea made to the council by the U.S. United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees. The UN agency had advised ICEM to adopt a flexible policy to cope with the world refugee problem in its entirety, regardless of the organization's mandate status.
