

**Cardinal Asks  
End To Strike**

Brussels — (RNS) — An appeal by Joseph Ernest Cardinal Van Roey, Archbishop of Malines, for an end to the "unreasonable" general strike in this country was broadcast by the Belgian Radio. The cardinal noted that to endure be rejected and continue the strike, marked by rigidly in demand by all honest men and already being by all who are imbued with a sense of justice and the common good.

The cardinal, whose appeal was promptly denounced by the strike organizers as "interference in national life and to paralyze the community's essential services," said that "all souls called to work in their daily tasks. May they become aware of their obligations and may they resume their labors without any further delay."
