Sister Ludolpha Dies, 42 Years At St. Joseph's

A Requiem Mass for Sister Mary Ludolpha Schultz of the School Sisters of Notre Dame will be offered in St. Joseph's Church, Franklin St., Saturday, Jan. 14 at 9 a.m.

Sister Ludolpha who taught business courses in St. Joseph's Commercial School on Franklin St., for 42 years, died Jan. 8, 1961 at Villa Maria in Notch Cliff, Md.

A NATIVE OF Brooklyn, Sister entered her community in 1895 at Baltimore and taught in Sacred Heart School there until 1910 when she joined the faculty of St. Joseph's Commercial School.

In 1952 she suffered a heart attack that forced her retirement. Sister Ludolpha had resided at Villa Maria since that time.

Sister returned to Rochester in 1954 to celebrate her Golden Jubilee and the 50th anniversary of the founding of the school. She is survived by a niece in Brooklyn.
