Nazi Victims, One A Nun personal leadership and spiritual direction of Catholic prices. Finds Brother In Israel

Jerusalem-(RNS)-Excitement rippled through the quiet South Judean colony of Ness Ziona when a Catholic nun came to the house of Israeli Air Force Captain Gad Manon on his 50th birthday and embraced him

Only slowly did the captain recognize in Rev. Mother Therese his sister with whom he had grown up in Berlin but had not seen since the Nazis came into power in Germany 28 years ago. They were known then as Gerda and Guenther Marous.

Guenther, who afterward changed his name into the modern Hebrew equivalent, left Germany after the Nazi revolution and served in Palestine with the British Army during World War I. Later he joined the Israeli Army. the meantime he had mourned his sister as one f Natism's millions of Jew-

gone to France, where she managed to avoid being arrested by the Nazi invaders, thanks to the help of Catholic nuns. They sheltered her in their convent and eventual-Iv she became a Catholic and entered the sisterhood herself.

Mother Marie Therese was recently transferred at her own request to the order's convent at Ramleh in Israel. Hoping against hope, that her brother might still be alive. she began a search that finally ended in Neiss Ziona.
