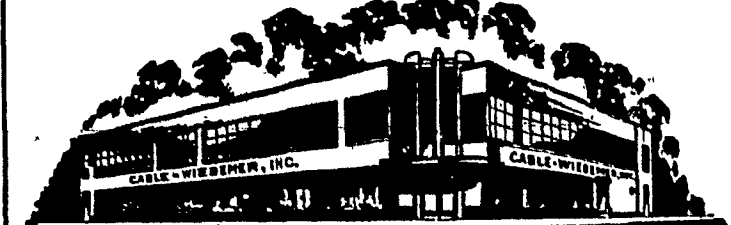

Pantry Shower Listed For Seneca Falls Nuns

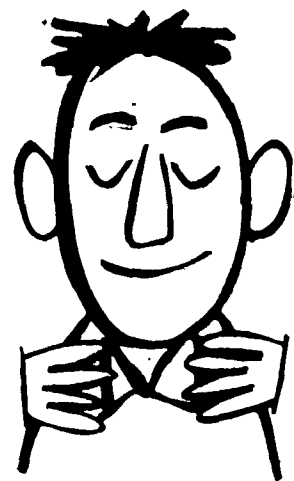

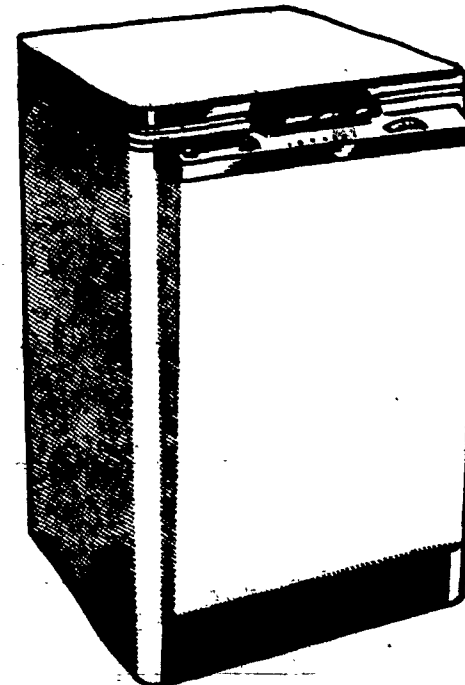
