

Non-immunized persons should take precautions against tetanus with all wounds, even the slightest, says the Red Cross, which has been teaching first aid for 50 years. Puncture wounds, especially those contaminated with barnyard soil or manure, probably cause the greatest number of tetanus cases, others result from injuries so slight the victims may have forgottem them. The particular need is for medical attention and possible immunication. Danger of tetanus ourphesizes the fact that the most insignificant wound should be cleaned without delay.
