### To Honor Father Hanna

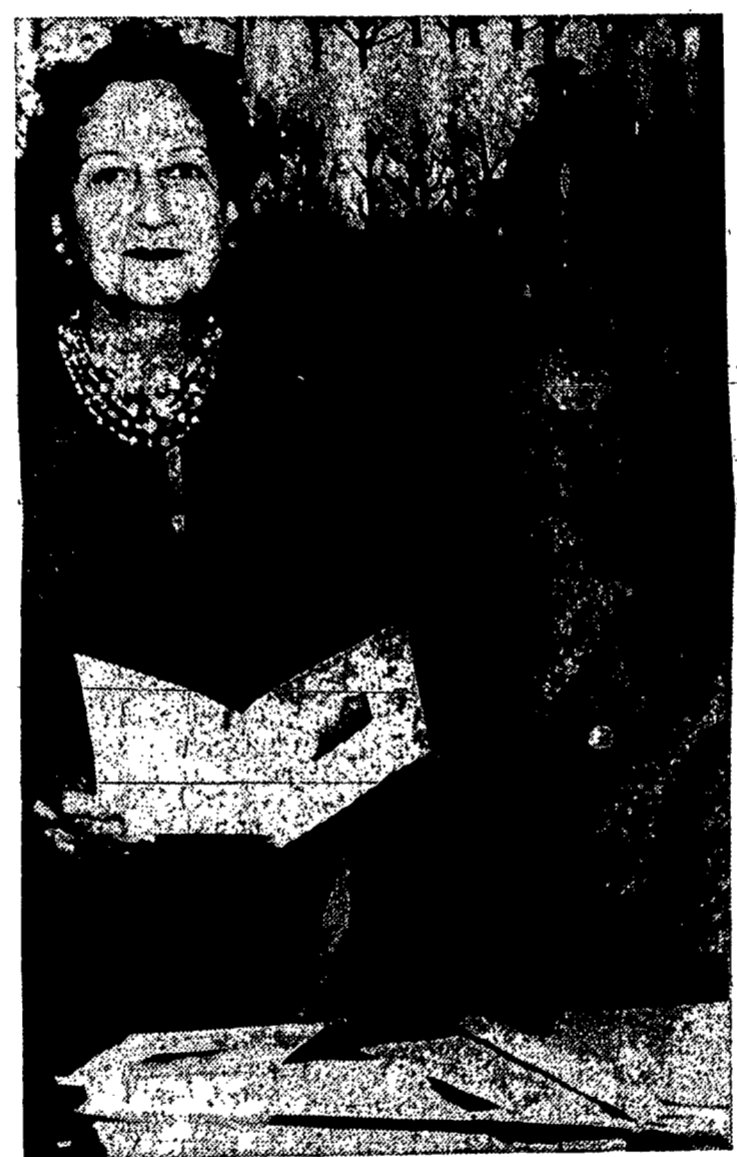

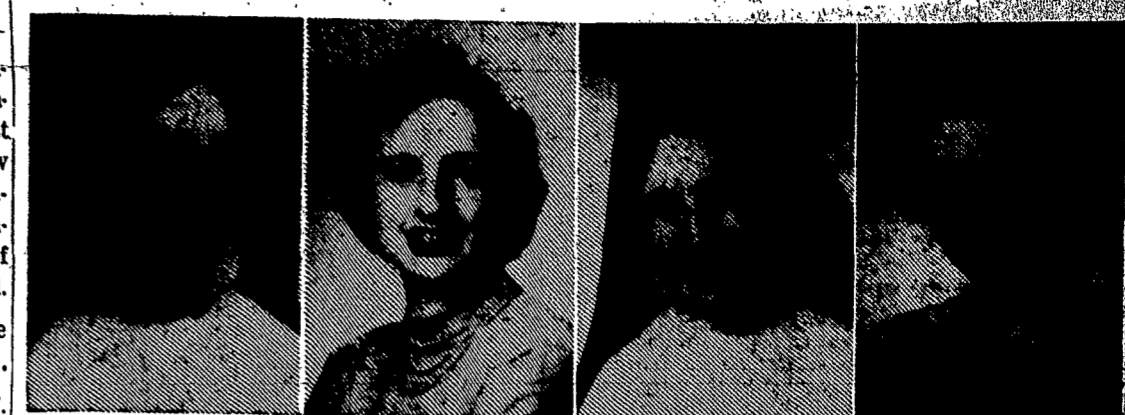

## Nazareth College Faculty, Students Win Science Awards

A member of the Nazareth College Science Department faculty, four students, and one alumna have been cited for distinguished scholarship in the sciences.

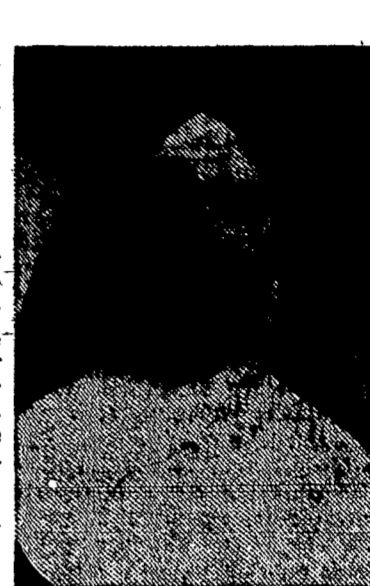
HEADING THE list of award winners released by the college yesterday was Sister Marie Augustine, chairman of the Nazareth College Chemistry Department, who has been chosen by the National Science Foundation to join a group of 24 college teachers who will attend the Summer Institute in Isotope Technology at Oak Ridge, Tennessee.

The institute, to be held July 24-September 1, is conducted by the Special Training Division of the Oak Ridge Institute of Nuclear Studies.

Sister Marie Augustine also received a grant last year which enabled her to attend the National Science summer institute for college teachers of chemistry at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. She received her master's degree from Catholic University of America and her doctorate from Institutum Divi Thomae.

Scholarships and assistantships at the University of Rochester have been awarded to Sister Joan Rowan, a 1959 graduate of the college who teaches at St. Agnes High School, and Diane Doran, a senior at the college.

Two other students received honorable mention awards in the 1961 National Science Foundation competition. Joyce Adamo, Waterloo, New York received a citation for distinction in mathematics and Marilyn Cahier of Victor for excellence in Botany. Miss Cahier will teach in the Rochester public schools next year and Miss Adamo is planning to continue her studies in graduate school. She has received several offers of fellowships.
