Couples contemplating marriage or newly married couples in any of the parishes of the Livingston Deanery are welcome.

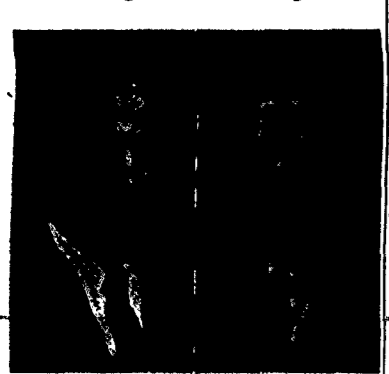
