

### Bishop Warns Against Frauds

Little Rock, Ark. — (RNS)—The Chancery Office of the Diocese of Little Rock issued a warning against fraudulent solicitors posing as representatives of Catholic organizations.

THE WARNING followed the arrest of 16 young out-of-state men who were rounded up in northwest Arkansas while posing as representatives of Boys Town in Omaha, Nebr. All of those arrested by police were released on bond.

In its warning, the Chancery Office reiterated the advice to Catholics that they ignore all solicitors representing themselves as agents of Catholic organizations, unless they carry written authorization from the local pastor.

Lisbon — (NC) — Relief supplies given by the United States and distributed by Catholic Relief Services-National Catholic Welfare Conference, worldwide agency of American Catholics, is on its way to refugees in the Portuguese territory of Luanda in southwest Africa.

THE 40 TONS of foodstuffs and 50 bales of clothing will be distributed among refugees from the nationalistic riots in north-western Angola, where about 200 of the white persons died in March.

The refugees have flocked to the capital city of Luanda.

### Science Finalists List 2 From Mercy

Shirley Venette and Gail Kin-sky, juniors at Our Lady of Mercy High School, placed as finalists in the Central Western Zone of the annual Science Congress for high school and junior high school pupils, according to George S. Curtice, director of the Congress.

The Science Congress was held at the State University College of Education, Brockport, Saturday, April 15, from 9:30 to 2:30.

Miss Venette and Miss Kin-sky emerged as finalists as a result of winning the second prize in the Mathematics Division at the Congress with their lecture-demonstration of a Division Table.

Friday evening, April 21, the two students will present their lecture-demonstration in competition with 11 other finalists at the Rochester Museum of Arts and Sciences. If they are among the three top winners, then they will be eligible for scholarships and state awards. Their entry will also go on to the New York State Science Congress at Albany on May 12 and 13.

ACCOMPANYING the two finalists to the dinner and competition will be Sister Mary Aquin, head of Mercy's math department, and Sister Mary Boraventure of Mercy, math faculty.

Prior to the Brockport Science Congress, the two Mercy juniors had won Honorable Mention at the Sub-Regional Science Fair, Mar. 25, at Pittsford Central. Their project grew out of Math Club investigations at their high school.

At Brockport a total of 336 exhibits and lecture-demonstrations was presented out of some 2,000 applications by high school students.
