MRS. W. CLANCY HARRINGTON, State Regent of the New York State Catholic Daughters of America spoke of the accomplishments of the order of the vestry ministry gift to each of the eight dioceses of New York State; the two-year-old project of giving scholarships to worthy students in each of the dioceses; the support given to His Holiness' programs for alleviating suffering through the Mission, Relief for Peace, and Storehouse Programs. **Little Rock Bishop Warns Parents On 'Premature' Marriage**  
Little Rock, Ark. — (RNS) — Bishop Albert L. Fletcher of Little Rock warned Catholic parents and their teenage children of the dangers involved in marrying prematurely and criticized young people going steady when they are economically unprepared for marriage.

In a pastoral letter read in all churches in the diocese, which comprises the state of Arkansas, Bishop Fletcher cited social changes in the last two generations that greatly restrict the possibility of successful early marriage.

"BACK THEN," he said, "the 16-year-old boy was either earning his own livelihood or contributing substantially to the family economy; the young girl of the same age often would be an experienced housekeeper."

Today, however, he added, "with the increase in the opportunities for education, a blessing by no means to be despised, our youth have more and more come to depend on parental assistance until they have completed high school or college."

"As a result . . . that time when the adolescent boy becomes a man of responsibility . . . (and) the adolescent girl becomes a woman of responsibility, arrives for youth at a later age than it once did in our country."
