

### KC Oratory Test Finals Listed Today

District winners from the six New York State Districts in the Diocese of Rochester will compete in the semi-final contest in Canandaigua, Friday, April 28 at 8 p.m. in St. Mary's Auditorium.

Winner of this contest will receive a one hundred dollar U.S. Savings Bond and will become a participant in the State Finals to be held in conjunction with the State Council Convention in New York City on May 26.

The topic of this year's contest is "Why I Want A College Education." Each speech is the original effort of the contestant and must be at least four minutes in length and not longer than five minutes.

THE THREE finalists will receive awards as follows: Winner: \$2,000 scholarship. Second: \$1,500 scholarship. Third: \$1,200 scholarship. The awards are paid to a Catholic College or University within the United States for the education of the winning contestant. Funds for the establishment of these scholarship grants are raised each year by the New York State Council Knights of Columbus in various activities.

Admission to the Oratorical Contest will be free and all interested spectators are welcome.

### Mercy High Newspaper Wins Honors

The Quill, school newspaper of Our Lady of Mercy High School, has been granted the Medalist award, the highest rating given in their judging by the Columbia Scholastic Press Association of New York City. The award was revealed during the past week in a communication received from the CSPA.

Medalist ratings are given to publications especially selected from the first place group for outstanding qualities. The award is given to not more than 10 percent of all entries in each division.

In addition the paper was awarded the All Columbia Award for News Stories, a rating given to only one newspaper in each division.

Editors of the Quill who submitted for judging include Mary Ann Binsack, Linda Kils and Nancy McHugh of the present senior class, and graduates of last year, Kathie McConville and Ann MacArthur.

The Columbia Scholastic Press Association conducts this judging yearly for college and high school newspapers, magazines and yearbooks.

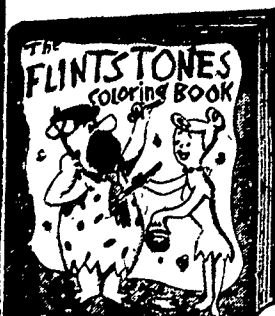
