Moderns Need St. Paul's Advice

Rome — (RNS) — Augustin Cardinal Bea, president of the Secretariat for the Promotion of Christian Unity, asserted here in a sermon that the modern-day world apply the doctrines of St. Paul to its problems.

The high-ranking prelate centered his sermon on what the saint would have to say to the modern world. The occasion was a commemoration festival at Reggio Calabria in Southern Italy to mark the arrival of St. Paul in Rome.

As advice to men exalted in technical progress and immersed in the world of materialism and the senses, the cardinal said the Apostle Paul taught that man should consider all things as creatures of the Lord.

"To men who lament their moral weakness, who suffer under the weight of their contradictions," he added, "St. Paul gave as a unique remedy:

"It is this God which guides all that gives a reason to the most acute sufferings and the most terrible tragedies and enables men to emerge victorious in the struggle against weakness and temptation," Cardinal Bea said.

The prelate declared that St. Paul gave humanity the divine plan of unity of the human race in Christ as the sole salvation against "the anguish that threatens us all and to justify the irresistible aspirations of present-day man to live peacefully."

Cardinal Bea said the forthcoming Second Vatican Council will be aiming for this unity "in the widest sense" by "efficiently promoting the union of all those baptized in Christ and bringing to the doubtful the Divine Image."

The German-born cardinal, the only Jesuit in the Sacred College, heads the secretariat which is preparing for the Council to be held in the Vatican, probably late next year.

St. Anthony's Fete Slated In Charlotte

The 49th annual St. Anthony's Festival will be celebrated on Saturday, June 10, in "Charlotte."

The festival, conducted in honor of St. Anthony of Padua, patron saint of the Charlotte community, was first held in 1913 with a few members of the Holy Cross Parish participating. The event has mushroomed into a community affair over the years with 25,000 expected to view and take part in the 1961 celebration.

The festival will open at 8:30 a.m. with a Solemn Mass at Holy Cross Church, 4492 Lake Ave., celebrated by the Rev. Robert H. Fennessy. There will be a procession from the school grounds which will include organizations from Holy Cross Parish and Knights of St. John.

ANNUAL PARADE will begin at 7:00 p.m. at Lake Ave. and St. Johns Pk., near Charlotte High School, and proceed north to Ontario Beach Park. The parade will include over 50 units in the line of march. Participating bands this year will be the New York State Champions, Holley High School Band, Aquinas, Nazareth, Gian McNaughton Scottish Band, 21st Regiment, Alpine Girls Corp. and several Drum and Bugle Corps. Also participating will be Eldorado's Baton Twirling group, Blue Angels, Silver Echoes, Veterans groups and color guards, Knights of St. John and Ladies Auxiliary Drill Team, St. Anthony's Society, Charlotte Social Club along with boy and girl scout groups, little league and many organizations from the community.

The Bon Jons and Beys will meet in softball following the parade at Harbor Diamond. There will be a band concert in the evening followed by a pyrotechnic fireworks display scheduled at 10:00 p.m. at Ontario Beach Park.

Rain date for parade and fireworks will be Sunday, June 11.
