In the cast with producer-actor Fred Graham are his former wife, Lilli Vanessi, Lois Lane, a singer and Bill Calhoun, who is Lois' primary interest.

The irresponsible Bill signs Fred Graham's name to a \$10,000 IOU; Graham and Lilli patch up their differences for a moment; Graham sends a bouquet to Lois but it is delivered to Lilli by mistake; when Lilli finds out about the intended bouquet she threatens to leave the show; her departure is prevented by two gangsters who have come to collect the IOU with Graham's signature; with Kate now really raging, the curtain falls on the first act.

In the second act it is learned that there has been a change in gang administration, so the gangsters tear up the IOU. Lilli prepares to leave the show but changes her mind and she and Graham are reunited.

The story is told between the scenes of a kind of musical version of Shakespeare's "Taming of the Shrew" whose characters draw a close parallel to those in the off-stage story. Earl Wrightson will appear as Fred Graham; Martha Errolle will play the shrew, Kate; Robert MacDonald, who will be remembered as Amy in last year's production of "Where's Charley" will be Lois Lane; and Alex Palermo, choreographer for this season, will be seen as Bill Calhoun.

Jim Harter, who was seen as Van Vuren in last week's "Damn Yankees" will play one of the gangsters and Leo Bloom who delighted audiences with his portrayal of Applegate (the devil) in "Yankees" will play the other gangster. The show opens on Monday, July 24 and will run for two weeks—closing on Saturday, August 5.

The touching, romantic comedy "A Majority of One" will be the next attraction at Cornhill Summer Theatre. This is the humor-wrapped tale of the improbable romance that springs up between a garrulous but wise Brooklyn widow and a wealthy Japanese industrialist when the New York housewife accompanies her daughter and diplomat son-in-law to Tokyo where she is able to cement international relations more successfully than the United States state department. The comedy starts Tuesday, July 25, for a week's run.
