20 St. Joseph Sisters Mark Jubilee

"Five hundred years of service to the Church." That's the way 20 members of the 1938 "band" of the Sisters of St. Joseph would like to sum up the past twenty-five years of their lives — and few other groups are so qualified to make that statement.

Twenty-five years ago, on July 4, 1936, 20 young women received the habit of their order. In 1941 those same twenty made their final vows. And this month the group, still intact and active, met on the Nazareth College campus to celebrate their silver jubilee.

Catholic War Vets List National Meet

Atlantic City — The 26th annual national convention of the Catholic War Veterans of the United States will open at the Ambassador Hotel here August 15, continuing through August 20.

Also prominent in educational circles are Sister M. Jamesetta, dean of elementary teacher education, Nazareth College; Sister Mary Elizabeth, reading consultant for the Sisters of Saint Joseph; Sister Albertus, who was this year named housemother at St. Joseph's Villa after many years of teaching in elementary schools; and Sister Anne Maurice, director of nursing education at St. Joseph's Hospital, Elmira.

This year's convention, of which the Department of New Jersey is host, will be dedicated to the 571 nursing sisters who served during the Civil War among the wounded of the Union Army.

How has the past quarter century been spent? Put very simply: serving God and His Church. In many ways that service has been rendered in ways invisible to the public eye. Since virtually all of the Sisters have spent a great part of the past 25 years teaching in area schools, however, a portion of that service is known and appreciated by a legion of parents and students.

SPECIAL PLAQUES will be presented to the more than 20 communities of nuns who served as battlefield nurses under the direction of the Surgeon General of the U.S. Army just a century ago.

OF THE 13 Sisters who are members of the faculty of area elementary schools, four are principals: Sister Helen Roberta, Sacred Heart School, Perkinsville; Sister Mary Paul, St. Anthony of Padua School, Rochester; Sister Joseph Catherine, St. Bridget's School, Rochester; Sister Jane Joseph,

Special programs are being provided for the wives of delegates, including fashion shows and special tours.

Rites In Singhalese

Colombo — (RNS) — In his capacity as Apostolic Delegate to Ceylon, Archbishop James R. Knox, Papal Internuncio to India, has given his official sanction to a Singhalese translation of the Roman ritual used in the administration of some Sacraments and various blessings.

The translation of the rites into Singhalese, the language of most Ceylonese, was ordered nearly 10 years ago by the Holy See. A counterpart of the translation in Tamil, the major language of Northern Ceylon, will be issued soon for the Jaffna diocese which covers the northern tip of the island.
