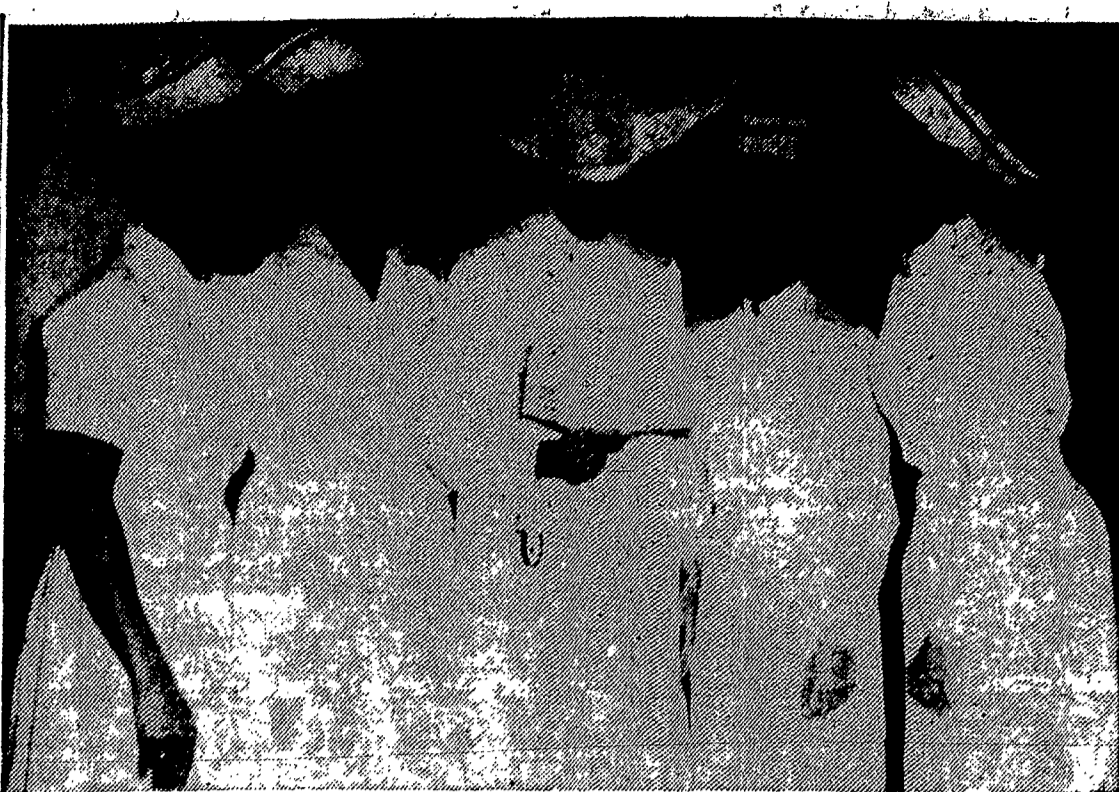

Orientation At St. Mary's

The Nursing Department of St. Mary's Hospital conducted an orientation program for the members of the Class of 1961 who are to become members of the Nursing Staff. The program was opened on Monday morning, Aug. 28, with a prayer offered by Father John Rosse, Hospital Chaplain.

FOLLOWING A brief address by Father Rosse, greetings were received from Sister Maria, Director of Nursing, Sister Mary Ellen, Hospital Administrator, extended greetings prior to a reception in honor of the new nursing staff in the afternoon.

On Monday morning, a panel on "Interdepartmental Relations" was moderated by Mrs. Dorothy Saffran. Panel members were: Sister Anthony Marie, Director of the Pharmacy; Mrs. Norma Walker, Chief Technician of X-Rays; Mrs. Mary E. Crowley, Chief Technician of the Laboratories; Mrs. Edna Barrall, Dietary Manager. In the afternoon, Thomas Burke, Personnel Director, discussed personnel policies. The role of the volunteers in the hospital was discussed by Miss Marie Lanigan, Public Relations Director, on Tuesday afternoon.

Following this, Dr. William T. Donovan, Director of the Medical Education Program at St. Mary's Hospital, and Mrs. Dorothy Saffran, Assistant Director of the Department, participated. Later, Sister Juliana, Business Manager, explained the payroll procedure to the group. Thursday afternoon, Miss Ruth Mandell, Coordinator of Clinical Nursing, led a discussion of "The Graduate Nurse's Role" in the Nursing Education Program.

The balance of the week was devoted to departmental orientation planned by the individual supervisors to acquaint the new nurses on each division with policies and procedures peculiar to each division.

Expectant Mothers Invited To Cathedral Blessing Rite

Expectant mothers will be given a special church blessing at Sacred Heart Cathedral following Rosary Guild services there Monday, Sept. 11 at 7:45 p.m.

The ceremony will comprise Rosary, Blessing of Mothers by Auxiliary Bishop Lawrence B. Casey and Benediction.

Bishop Casey said that mothers-to-be from Rochester and suburban parishes are invited to attend the Cathedral rite to receive the blessing.

Bishop Casey will also confer a blessing with a relic of St. Gerard Majella. St. Gerard is popularly called "The Mother's Saint."

THE RITUAL blessing to be given by Bishop Casey includes the prayer for mother and child:

"Receive the sacrifice of the contrite heart and the ardent desire of thy servant who humbly asks Thee for the welfare of the child which Thou didst grant her to conceive. Guard the work which is Thine and defend it from all the deceit and harm of our bitter Enemy, so that the hand of Thy mercy may assist her delivery, and her child may come to the light of day without harm, be kept safe for the holy birth of Baptism, serve Thee always in all things, and attain to everlasting life."
