

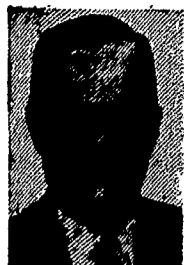


### Nurses Convene Here

### FHA's Hardy Urges Quality In Housing

The Federal Housing Administration encourages the construction of sound homes and recognizes that quality items in homes frequently are sound economically because they result in lower maintenance costs and a more livable unit.

In this respect, the new housing bill before Congress should be of interest to owners of existing homes. That will stress rehabilitation and improvement of existing homes and liberalizes the terms by which these projects can be carried out by home owners. By raising the limit on loans for home improvement from \$3,500 to \$10,000, the new bill would make it possible for home owners to carry out extensive rehabilitation, including installation of quality products and equipment such as permanently installed air conditioning.

Research has demonstrated that air conditioning has beneficial effects on the general well-being of a home's occupants. Today it can be installed at much less cost than ever before, and when the home is properly insulated, operating costs for air conditioning may be considered reasonable for the benefits derived.

For these reasons, air conditioning in housing passed the gadget or even the luxury stage long ago. Now, in many areas, it has been accepted either as a necessity or as a normal accessory.

### Banks To Install Photogards

Cameras designed to record in motion pictures any holdup attempt will be installed at all four offices of Columbia Banking Saving & Loan Association, Rochester and Newark. Columbia is among the first in the Upstate area to order these new devices which have been highly successful in New York City.

Called Photogard by the maker, Mosler Safe Company, the cameras are electronically operated 16mm machines so placed that they will automatically film the faces and activities of suspects.

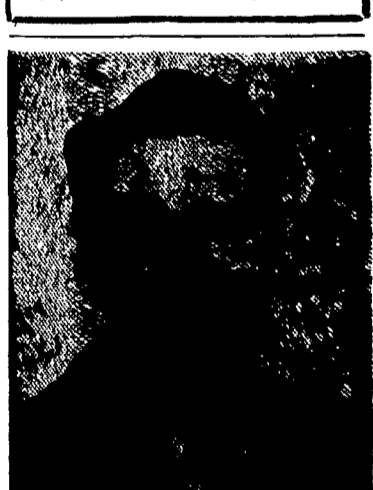

to a home's winter welfare is the condition of the roof. This is where winter's hardest blows land; scraping ice, melting snow, severe temperature changes, harsh winds.

**Leaks Are Threat**

Most any home owner can get a fair idea of whether his roof will protect the house through the long winter by merely looking at it. If it looks shabby, it probably is worn out and will have to be replaced. A closer inspection can be made in the attic during a rainstorm. Darkened areas along eek boards and rafters indicate leaks. This means the entire roof is weak, since roofing material wears out uniformly.

When a roofing contractor confirms the home owner's analysis, chances are he'll recommend a new roof of asphalt shingles at a price that generally is a pleasant surprise. This is because asphalt shingles go in place quickly over old roofing material, keeping the labor cost of applying them at a low level.
