

'Seven Wonders' Makes Debut

"Seven Wonders of the World" makes its debut in Rochester Jan. 18 as the second Cinema feature at the Monroe Theatre. There will be matinees at 2:30 p.m. on Wednesdays, Saturdays and holidays and evening performances daily at 8:30 p.m.

Pope Pius XII is seen in the film in a procession through the plaza before St. Peter's in Vatican City, taking part in the completion of Marian Year ceremonies.

The Monroe Theatre is the only theatre in central western New York equipped to show Cinemas. A giant curved screen is used to bring the viewers "into the picture." High fidelity stereophonic sound completes the effect.
