

McQuaid Faces Canisius, East

McQuaid Jesuit High's 6-2 basketball record will be confronted with two substantial obstacles to its betterment this weekend. Tonight the Knights play host to a tall Canisius team from Buffalo and 24 hours later, they'll hop over to East High to take on the current City League leaders.

CANISIUS, a team that shows a 6-7 pivotman and a 6-5 forward on its starting roster, is always tough for McQuaid, as evidenced by the pair of setbacks suffered by the Knights last year at the hands of the Little Griffs. The Buffalo school was a 1-point overtime loser to Fordham Prep, which topped McQuaid by 15 three weeks ago. Even for non-believers in comparative scores, that points to a peak effort by the Knights if a win is to be had.

McQuaid's two big men — 6-4 Gerry McCabe and 6-2 Tony Criscuolo — hold a good deal of the Knights' hopes tonight. They'll have to stay close in the rebounding battle if the scoring of McQuaid's Criscuolo — Frank Zona-Joe Genier trio is to mean anything. Filling out the starting squad will be the junior Dick Spiess, who had a season only limited until he opened against Jefferson last week.

Student Wins Medical Study Scholarship

A St. John Fisher College English major has won a New York State Regents Scholarship for medicine — and he did it by finishing third in the state (exclusive of New York City) in the annual competition examination.

Joseph F. Scholand, a senior at the college, was one of three Rochester area students to win medical scholarships. The others were Gerard W. Frank, a senior at LeMoyne College in Syracuse and Robert J. Sokol, a junior at the University of Rochester.

SCHOLAND WAS one of a group of 72 students who won scholarships for medical study in New York State. Half of the total number of scholarships is allotted to New York City students.

Each scholarship entitles the holder to from \$350 to \$1,000 a year, depending upon financial need, for four years while attending a medical school in the state. Students are also eligible for scholar-incentive assistance of from \$200 to \$800 a year.

Scholand, the son of Frank Scholand of 138 Ogden-Parnas Road, Spencerport, has already been accepted at both Johns Hopkins and Harvard University medical schools. He had previously won Regina O'Doherty, Kearney, Regents and Frank Gannett Newspapers' boy scholarships for undergraduate work and a full-tuition scholarship at Aquinas Institute.

THE ST. JOHN Fisher senior has been active in school activities and was editor of the college newspaper in his sophomore year. He is the oldest of four brothers, two of whom are now attending Aquinas, the other Spencerport High School. His father is an employee of Eastman Kodak Company.

His academic background in English and the humanities, he feels, will help and not hinder his progress in medicine. "Most medical schools now," he says, "prefer a student to have a broad academic base in liberal arts. Extensive training in the sciences can come in medical school."
