**Prelate Resigns Patriarchate**

Vatican City — (RNS) — Pope John XXIII has accepted the resignation of Gregory Peter XV Cardinal Agagianian, Prefect of the Sacred Congregation for the Propagation of the Faith, from his post as spiritual leader of the world's Armenian Catholics, it was reported here.

Vatican sources said the 66-year-old prelate had asked to be relieved of his duties as Patriarch Catholics of Cilicia of the Armenians because of the pressure of his work in the Roman Curia. He has held the patri-

**Knights Plan Shrine Trip**

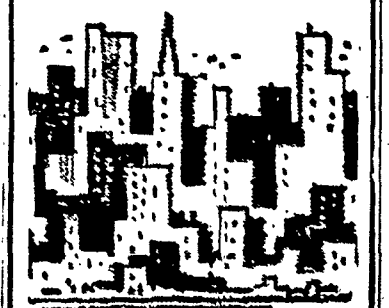
