Noonday Book Review Given On Council

"Like a small rolling stone which causes an avalanche, this small book has set off a wide-spread response. No other book has caused so many people to actually think about the coming Council."

So began the Rev. Joseph Brennan's critique of "The Council, Reform and Reunion," by German theologian Hans Kung. This was the first in the Fall series of the Noonday Book Reviews, which began last Tuesday at the Catholic Evidence Library.

"Father Kung's work on the Council is, in a way, an examination of conscience — of the Church in the past, and present — and tentatively, a plan of improvement for the future."

THE REVIEWER, professor of Scripture at St. Bernard's Seminary, noted that some Catholic sensibilities might be annoyed by Kung's account of our collective shortcomings. He felt that these would be balanced by the author's obvious love for the Church, and his honesty in facing the facts.

"If he is more optimistic about the possibilities for the reunion of all Christians than most of us, it can be attributed to his own experience," Father Brennan said. He pointed out that the dialogue between Catholics and Protestants in Germany had advanced further than it has in America.

Even Father Kung warns his reader not to expect a "miraculous reunion" to spring forth from the Council. He does hope that the Council will establish a climate, begin to pave the way for the steps which will eventually lead to reunion.

"For a serious subject, this is a most readable book, and for the average reader, will be an eye-opener on the possibilities of the Council," was Father Brennan's closing comment.

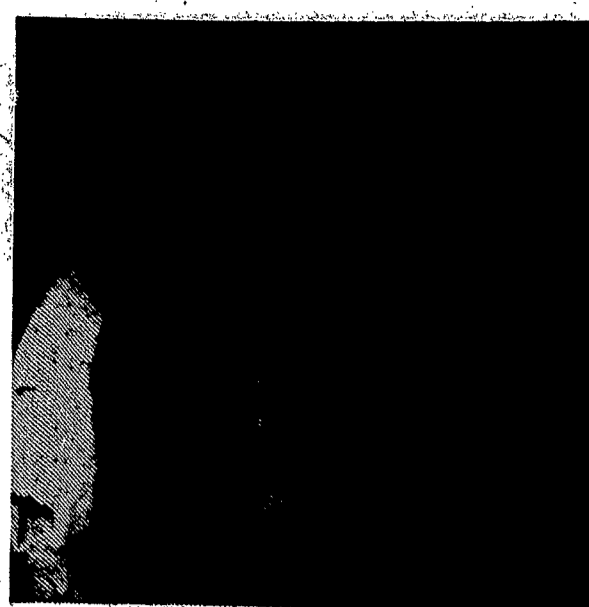

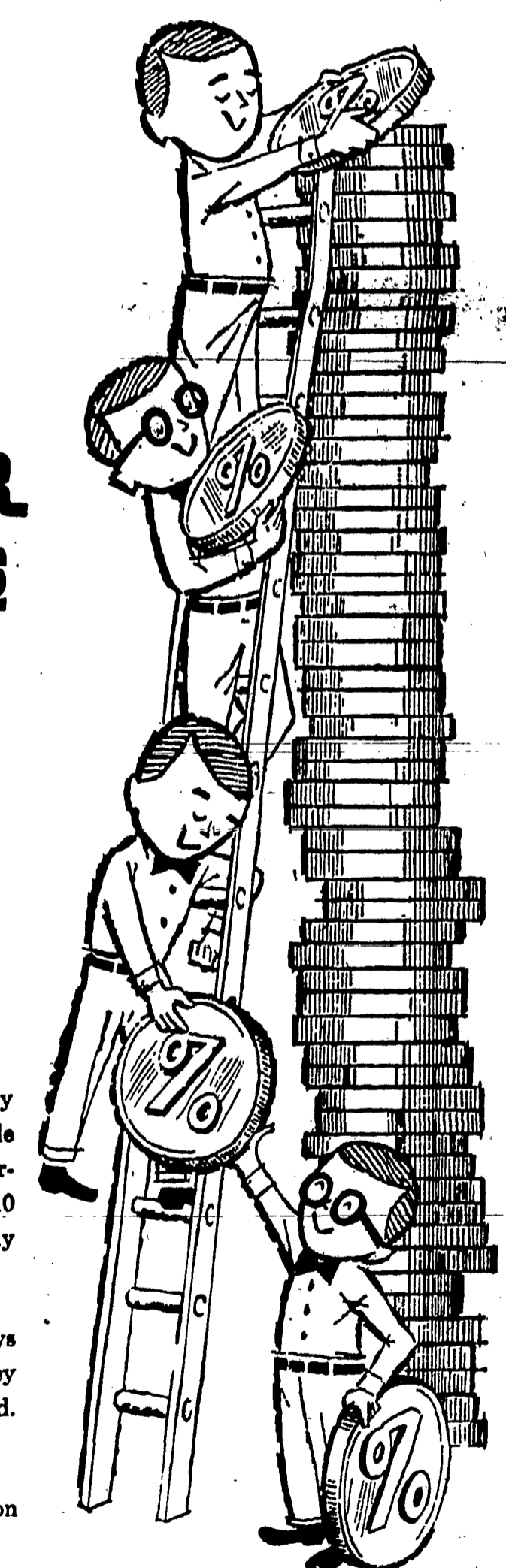
