**E. ENCOURAGE CIRCULATING DATING:** Circulating dating — having dates with many different boys within groups of the girl's own age — should be constantly encouraged because:

1. It aids in personality growth.
2. It provides variety of experiences.
3. It offers wide comparison and study of better escorts.
4. It restrains adolescent 'falling in love.'
5. It protects moral safety.

**F. GOING STEADY SHOULD BE DISCOURAGED.** Going steady should be discouraged for all high schoolers. It is unwise because:

1. It deprives a girl of many enjoyable friendships.
2. It deprives her personality growth in the years when she needs a variety of experiences and acquaintances for full social development.
3. It causes moods and day-dreams which injure family harmony, interfere with school work.
4. It makes readjustment to normal social dating difficult when the 'going steady' experience breaks up.
5. It increases dangers of moral temptations, sin and shame through increasing familiarity.
6. It teaches her false ideas of 'love' based on physical attractions only.
7. It prematurely intensifies her desire for marriage.

**G. WHAT PARENTS SHOULD KNOW ABOUT DATES.** Before approving of a daughter's dating plans, parents should know:

1. Who are her escort and companions.
2. Specific details on where they are going and what they will do.
3. Plans for her transportation.
4. The time of her return home.

**A. VALUE OF DATING EXPERIENCES.** Dating, properly supervised by parents, is a natural and valuable experience for the growing girl. Ideally, it provides opportunity for a variety of acquaintances and activities to aid in the development of her social maturity.
