### 'Long Journey' In Separate Class

New York — (NC) — The National Legion of Decency disclosed it has separately classified the movie "Long Day's Journey Into Night," an Embassy film adapted from the Eugene O'Neill play. The legion said that "the drama requires maturity in the viewer because of its difficult theme and strong language."

The legion noted the film lacks a Code Seal of Approval from the Motion Picture Association of America and said Embassy Pictures Corp., its distributor, will advertise the movie as "recommended for mature audiences." The legion's separate classification is reserved for films which are not morally offensive but require caution and some analysis and explanation as a protection to the uninformed against wrong interpretations and false conclusions.

The legion made this observation about the film: "With minor differences this film is an exact transference to the screen of the reputedly autobiographical play of the same title by the late Eugene O'Neill. A powerful but tortured probe into the tragic recesses of the playwright's familial experience, the drama requires maturity in the viewer because of its difficult theme and strong language."

# Lady of Mexico

LADY OF MEXICO — Do all the pilgrims who rush to Fatima forget the shrine to Our Lady on their own continent? Black friars is now reminding us of the charming story of Guadalupe when Heaven's Queen saw fit to visit her humble Mexican Christian in 1531 when avivice was tempting some of the Spaniards to exploit them.

The message she sent, however, was duly delivered to the good Franciscan Bishop Zimarraga by the Indian neophyte, Juan Diego, and the red Castilian roses he had plucked in the desert snows were proof enough of the apparition he had seen even without the image of Our Lady miraculously painted on his tilma (cloak) which is still the treasure of the great church just outside Mexico City.

LADY OF MEXICO is a miniature opera written by the delightfully literary Poor Clare, Sister Mary Francis with the score and its beautiful chorals composed by the Reverend Joseph Roff, Master of Arts in Romance Languages, Doctor of Music, a musician of note, now a curate in Brooklyn.

One of the finest singers in the show is a butcher from Hoboken. The orchestra sits in the front row seats of the orchestra around the piano, the soloists being too small for them. The Rios as Juan Diego; E. D. M. Joey as the Bishop; Alfred Coda as Fray Fernando and Jenni Sparks as the Virgin all do great justice to their parts in a well staged, well sung and most sympathetic production.

"WHO'S AFRAID OF VIRGINIA WOOLF?" Although the scene is a College campus and the four characters involved are two faculty members and their wives, they are barbarians who might well make an honest Hun blush. The time is 2:30 a.m. in the living room of the history professor and his wife, Martha, who arrive from a party given by the College President who is Martha's father. Martha is a big blonde, sensual, vulgar, irascible, who announces to her husband's wrath that she has invited the new biology professor and his bride to drop in for a drink on their way home.

Martha and George are drunk when they first appear, so are their guests. From 8:00 p.m.—11:15 p.m. our time and from 2:30 a.m.—5:00 a.m. stage time. History and Biology empty bottles of Scotch while the girl sips cognac and Martha downs pure gin—its the only pure thing about her. Her speech is blank-blank.

At first George's sharp wit elicits some sympathy for him during Martha's coarse jeers but as alcohol undresses his soul it appears as foul as his wife's. To void his spleen at Martha, George turns his satirical sarcasm on her guests but when it comes to hurting the girl, even Martha objects and he almost chokes her — too bad he didn't as then, after cuffing her efficiently into silence, George begins to torture her with the one decency they share; the dream son who is nearly twenty-one.

That such earth chained people as George and Martha should have a dream is difficult to imagine. This is the first three act play of William Albee whose ZOO STORY has brought him international recognition. It is reported that he refused any pruning of his verbose script which was his mistake. Mr. Albee is brilliant but unmannered. Alan Schneider, as director, has cast the characters superbly.
