

Buffalo Doctor Listed For Lecture At Fisher

How does a physician become an expert on Eastern Rites of the Catholic and Orthodox Churches?

In the case of Dr. Chester J. Fortuna of Buffalo, who will lecture at St. John Fisher College next Tuesday, Nov. 20, it happened because of a mistake he made here in the late 1940's.

DR. FORTUNA will speak on "Eastern Rites of the Catholic Church — Unity through Diversity" at 10:30 a.m. in the college auditorium. The program is part of the informal lecture series on public affairs scheduled by the college's political science department.

As a resident physician at Eola Sanitarium here about 15 years ago Dr. Fortuna set out one Sunday morning to attend Mass. By mistake, he went to St. Joseph's Ukrainian Church in Hudson Ave., services are in

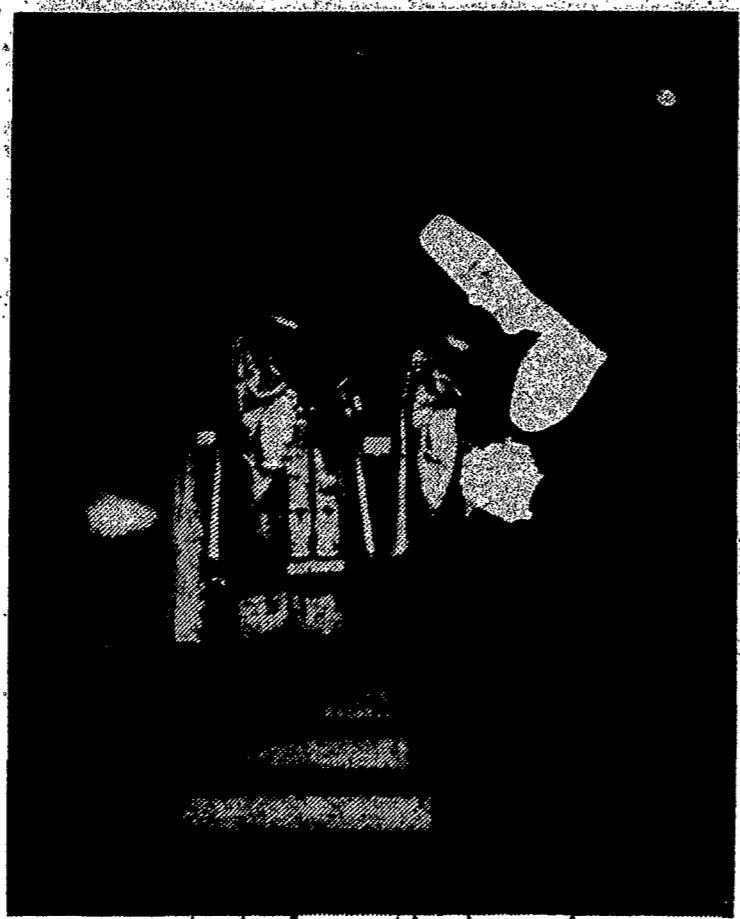
the Byzantine Ukrainian rites of the Catholic Church.

His interest aroused, Dr. Fortuna began a study which has made him a widely recognized authority on Eastern rites of the Catholic and Orthodox Churches. He now has a private book collection on the subject which exceeds 1,300 volumes, as well as art objects and icons connected with Eastern Churches.

Part of Dr. Fortuna's collection will be exhibited at the college when he lectures. The exhibit will also include books, art objects and icons on the same subject owned by Professor John Solowski of the Rochester Institute of Technology Art Department.

A graduate of the University of Buffalo and the St. Louis University School of Medicine, Dr. Fortuna is a specialist in roentgenology.

Stefan C. Maczynski, assistant professor of political science at the college, is in charge of arrangements for the lecture, which is open to the public.
