Canisius Edges 19-12 Victory Over McQuaid

By JESS HEWITT. Staging what was probably its best performance of the year, McQuaid Jesuit High carried the battle to a favored and undefeated Canisius High eleven right down to the final gun.

The Knights finished with a 4-31 record in their first season under the coaching of Tom Seymour and Frank Noce.

With five seconds remaining in the Canisius battle, McQuaid's Dick Spies passed down the middle to halfback Bill Bruckel for a 30-yard gain that put the ball inside the Crusaders' 30.

Time ran out on that play, and it was an appropriate end-

ing for the stirring offensive show put on by the two clubs.

McQuaid, with 168 yards in the air and 162 on the ground, out-gained the winners' exclusively ground attack, 330-329.

AT ONE KEY juncture in the game, though, Canisius rose up to stop the Knights inside the 10-yard line, and that proved to be the difference in the end.

It was Zernentsch who proved to be the thorniest problem the Knights had to face all day. But before he had a chance to torment them further, Spies and Co. came right back with a 56-yard scoring thrust. Spies himself got things rolling with a keeper play and kept mixing passes to Bruckel and handoffs to Pezzulo and Ralph Camardo to advance the ball to the Canisius 2.

There, after the Crusaders had thrown him for a 2-yard loss, Spies crossed up the defense with a little lob pass into the flat where Joe Hallett gathered it in for 6 points.

A fumble killed the vital extra point try, and Zernentsch, on a 57-yard bolt through a tightly-massed McQuaid defense, upheld the margin to 13-6 at halftime.

Canisius was able to mount only one good drive in the second half but turned it into a score on Sansone's 9-yard off right end. McQuaid on the other hand moved inconsistently, once on the bid that petered out, again on a drive that saw penalties take their toll, and, finally, after the Knights had blocked a Canisius punt with 4 minutes remaining in the game.

They clicked for their second score on the last occasion, with Bruckel hauling in Spies' 14-yard pass over his shoulder as he crossed the goal line.

19 Cage Games On McQuaid Slate

The accent will be on new faces when McQuaid Jesuit High opens its basketball season next Wednesday at home against Spencerport. New coach Ken Jones, who is also in his first year as Director of Athletics, has only four players back from last season's 17-3 championship team; and one of them — 6-4 center Gerry McCabe — suffered a broken wrist on the first day of practice.

McCabe will likely be sidelined for another two weeks, leaving seniors Dick Spies, Dick Updew, and Jan Yutz as the only varsity holdovers available for

the opener. Only Spies saw regular duty last year, and he'll go into the opener with less than 10 days of practice, due to the late completion of his football chores. So the scramble for varsity berths is as wide open as it's ever been at McQuaid.

MOVING UP from the junior varsity to make a bid are juniors Pete Menihan, Tony Binsack, Joe Miller, Buzz Ashenburg, Joe Connellan, Brian Fitzpatrick, John Wolf, Sam Iannaccone, Dave Coiro, Walt Knipper, and Vince Basso. Sophomores Lance Comps, Tony Leonardo, and Mike Spiegel are also very much in the picture, with a last cut still to be made.

McQuaid's 18-game schedule is highlighted once again by games against Aquinas in December and March. A notable addition this season is the Jesuit Invitation Tournament at Fordham University over the Christmas vacation.
