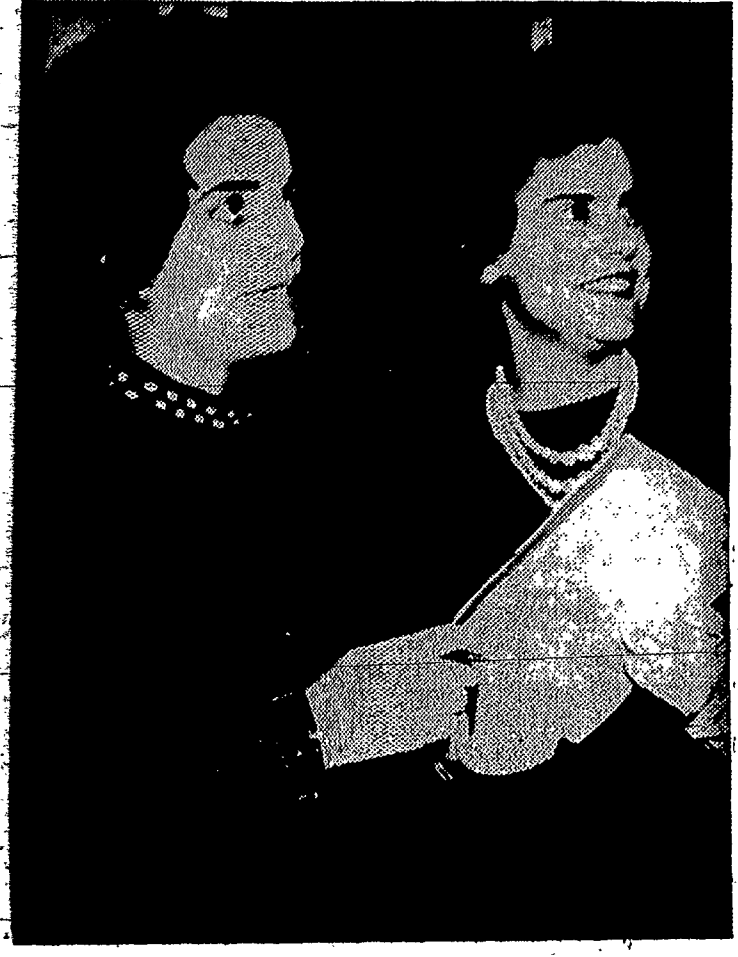




### Lawrence Couple Marks 60 Years

### 'Serpent's Delight' Review Given By Ruth Ashburn

"The Serpent's Delight" is a novel of fine characterization, filled with true-to-life people," concluded Miss Ruth Ashburn at last Tuesday's Noonday Book Review. She scrutinized Ruth Park's new novel at the Catholic Evidence Library, in the fifth of a bi-weekly book review series being presented there.

"THE EMPHASIS is not so much on the story, which is interesting enough, but on the impact of a claimed apparition on an Australian family. The youngest daughter, 18-year old Geraldine, claims that she has seen the Blessed Virgin Mary. The subsequent effect on her family, the stresses and strains it brings — is all beautifully portrayed by this gifted storyteller," she said.

Ruth Park, a transplanted New Zealander now living in Australia, is a Catholic writer who squeezes in her literary efforts amidst her home duties

— she is the mother of five young children.

"The Pond family is a very real family," stressed Miss Ashburn, "—very lovable, very human. They rub against each other, bicker sometimes, have strong feelings, but are bound by a strong familial love."

The reviewer is a librarian in charge of the "Teen Lounge" at the Rundle Memorial Library. She is also Librarian and Literature chairman of the Council of Catholic Women, Monroe County County.
