### Civil Defense Honors Won By Trappist

**Fiftieth**—Certificates of completion of a Radiological Monitoring Course were presented to one priest and nine monks at Our Lady of the Genesee Monastery.

**IN PRESENTING** the certificates, Alvin J. Hayes, Livingston County Civil Defense Director, complimented the class for their interest in the Civil Defense program and for the high scholastic grades attained in the final test. Robert Gillen, instructor stated that the average grade of 90 was the highest for any class he has taught.

During the Berlin crisis of 1961 a fallout shelter was built and stocked at the monastery. This shelter has been designated a Radiological Fixed monitoring station for the Livingston County Civil Defense, one of twenty-five to be established in the county.

The necessary instruments for monitoring fallout were delivered to the monastery by Director Hayes on Saturday, Nov. 24, the time of the graduation of the monitoring class.

### School's Right To Expel OK'd

Albany — (RNS) — New York State's highest court ruled here that a Roman Catholic university had the right to expel three Catholic students for participating in a civil marriage ceremony.

The Court of Appeals, by a vote of 7 to 2, said St. John's University of Brooklyn had acted "not arbitrarily, but in the exercise of an honest discretion" in expelling the students.

Expelled were Howard G. Carr, his wife, Greta Schmidt Carr, and Miss Jean Catto, who was a witness to the civil marriage of the couple in March. Another witness, also expelled, did not contest the school's action.
