

Home Show Scheduled At War Memorial

Rochester's \$10,000,000 Home Show takes over both the Space Administration levels of the War Memorial. The space agency will show replicas May 4-11, and for the first time the Mercury, Telstar, and Gemini 4-14 year history will be Venus Mariner space vehicles open to the public without a film of Col. John Glenn's orbital flight.

Over 100,000 persons are expected to attend this year's lower level of the War Memorial Show, and according to Angelo P. Gallina, chairman, visitors will combine a variety of exhibits from the 1960s to the 19th century. The Rochester suburbs will be presented by American, Victorian, and Edwardian. The whole second-floor display will be shown from Midtown Plaza, and Edwards and Sibley's municipal central walk-through ramp. Garage to the War Memorial hours of the exhibition will be from 1 p.m. to 10 p.m. on the two Sundays and one Saturday.

AS COMPARED to a previous Show will offer almost 300 booth displays. Participants in this year's record of 149, this year's include builders of new homes, builders, suppliers, appliance stores, insurance companies, public utilities, radio and television stations and town governments.

Major attractions will include a replica of Col. John Glenn's space capsule on the main floor of the War Memorial, an loan executive vice-chairman.

Hours of the exhibition will be from 1 p.m. to 10 p.m. on


Planting Hints to Observe

Keep these rules in mind in designing your planting . . .

- Plan simply and sparingly; no restraint in buying plants.
- Blend textures and colors harmoniously for pleasing results.
- Know the plants you are buying—height, manner of growth, foliage and flower color.
- Use typical forms or geometric outlines in sketching designs.

Enjoy Gardening

You can make and raise lightweight, easily-manipulated gardens that's a beautiful frame around your home with a little patience, a lot of enthusiasm and these few pointers.

• Don't plant too deep. Small flower or vegetable seeds only need to be covered. When reseeding bare patches in your lawn, loosen two inches of soil and sow.

• Too much fertilizer is much worse than using too little. See label directions on package of a reliable manufacturer.

• Overwatering causes water to leach out of the soil and become runoff. Let your turf dry almost to the wilting point before watering, and then soak it to a depth of six inches. You might consider a corrugated rainwater harvesting steel sprinkler, which will give you many years of service. Its great advantage is that it furnishes water only as fast as the ground can absorb it.

• Mow your lawn, but don't "strip" it. Set your mower at one-and-a-half inches high; now whenever the grass gets over two inches, if mower blades get dull, they'll split the grass tops, causing them to turn straw. The blades should be made of high carbon or alloy steel which makes them rugged—so they won't chip when they hit a rock—and hard, so that when the blades are sharpened, they will stay sharp for a long time. Once a year have the blades removed, ground and balanced.


• Buy good garden tools, as they won't have to be replaced periodically. Steel tools are


